

Events Conducted by the Department

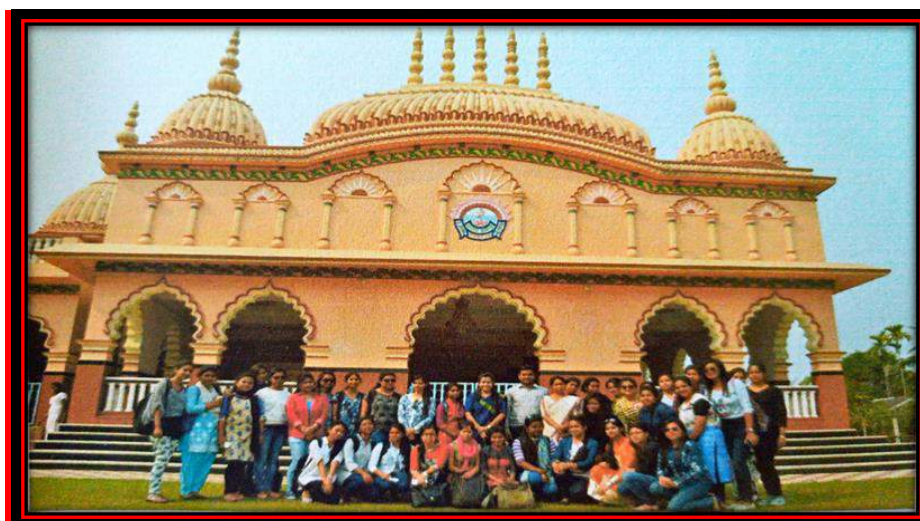
2017- 2018
