DETAILS OF RESOURCE PERSONS AND OUTLINE OF THE SESSIONS

The Course was conducted on the Learning Management System (LMS) developed by the Research Development and Services Cell, Ramanujan College and was self-paced in nature. Dr. Jaspreet Kaur, Pearl Academy; Dr. Vibhash Kumar, Dr. Nikhil Rajput from Ramanujan College, Prof. CS Sharma, Shri Ram College of Commerce and Ms. Anupama Yadav, Ashmar Technology Ltd. were the resource persons for the programme.

<u>Dr. Jaspreet Kaur</u>: Dr.Jaspreet Kaur is an associate professor at Pearl Academy. She has over 16 years of teaching experience in Marketing research. She has authored two books on Customer relationship Management and Service Marketing and has written many research papers in Scopus and ABDC journals. She is an Editor and Reviewers to many ABDC and Scopus journals like International journal of consumer studies (Wiley) and Management Decisions (Emerald). She is an AMT certified faculty from AIMA and has received the GRABS "Best researcher Award" in 2008 and the ITSR "Best researcher's Award" in 2020.

Dr. Jaspreet Kaur, having specialized in Consumer behaviour and Market research, has been teaching the same at PG and UG level for the past 10yrs. She has authored 2 books, course packs for Universities and research and business articles for Journals in Marketing management. Her key area of interest in research is Consumer behaviour for Online marketing.

<u>Dr. Vibhash Kumar</u>: Dr. Vibhash Kumar is an Associate Professor at Jindal Global Business School, O.P Jindal Global University. In his previous assignments, Dr. Kumar has donned leadership roles as Assistant Director of Teaching Learning Centre and course coordinator of National Resource Centre, Ramanujan College, under the coveted PMMMNMTT scheme of the Ministry of Education. Dr. Kumar has been the founding managing editor of RIJBR, a UGC Care-listed journal.

Dr. Kumar has also contributed as an author for the Institute of the Life Long Learning, University of Delhi, E-PG Pathshala sponsored by the Ministry of Education for developing post-graduate teaching material, and the National Mission on Education (NME) project sanctioned by the Ministry of Education. Dr. Kumar has convened numerous FDPs, MDPs, and Conferences and has conducted scores of faculty development programs & workshops on Research Methodology, Academic Writing, Academic Integrity, and Hands-on Sessions on research tools in prestigious institutions like Calcutta University, Hans Raj College, SPM College, Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, Sri Venkateshwara College, Sri Aurobindo College, Institute of Home Economics, South Campus of the University of Delhi; Jamia Milia Islamia University; Christ University Bangalore; and JIMS & MAIMS of IP University.

Dr. Nikhil Kumar Rajput: Dr. Nikhil Kumar Rajput, doctorate in Computer Science from Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi is currently associated with Ramanujan College in the capacity of Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science and Assistant Director of the Teaching Learning Centre, Ramanujan College. He has also been the Coordinator for the National Resource Centre which was awarded to Ramanujan College under the Ministry of Education. In 2015, Dr. Rajput represented University of Delhi in West College, Scotland, under the UK India Education Research Initiative (UKIERI) project. He was among nineteen delegates selected by TAFE, Australian to visit Canberra under Australia-India VELT program, 2017.

Ms. Anupama Yadav: Ms. Anupama Yadav is associated with AshmarIP as Principal-Buisness Development-Global. She has an extensive hands-on experience on various aspects of IPR.

Intellectual Property Rights Ms. Anupama Yadav

The session elaborated the meaning of copyright, patent and IPR and discussed what all can be protected under the copyright act. Ms. Yadav discussed the different reasons for ensuring copyright protection by exploring it in terms of economic, moral and related rights. She then discussed each right in further detail. Ms. Yadav also elucidated the process of protecting any creation and the terms of copyright. Using a case study, she gave a comprehensive explanation about the procedure of filing a copyright.

OER and Creative Commons License Dr. Nikhil Rajput

The session discussed about Open Educational Resources and its application in making teaching learning more effective. Many faculty already use OER in their classes — showing YouTube videos, using worksheets created and shared by other faculty, and using online simulations as learning activities. Dr. Rajput explained that one can use Wikipedia, gutenberg.org, MIT OpenCourseWare, cnx.org, open.edu are OER's which can assist in the creation of MOOCs using their available content online. One can access OER's through oerworldmap.org. University of Pittsburgh also offers a vast knowledge base of OER's.

The final session elucidated about Creative Commons License. Dr. Rajput explained that Creative Commons copyright licenses and tools forge a balance inside the traditional "all rights reserved" setting that copyright law creates. The tools give everyone from individual creators to large companies and institutions a simple, standardized way to grant copyright permissions to their creative work. It facilitates a pool of content that can be copied, distributed, edited, remixed, and built upon, all within the boundaries of copyright law.

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Plagiarism Prevention Dr. Vibhash Kumar

Academic integrity is the intellectual honesty in proposing, performing, and reporting any activity which leads to the creation of intellectual property. In the session, Dr. Vibhash Kumar explained the meaning of Plagiarism as an act of academic dishonesty and a breach of ethics. It involves using someone else's work as one's own. It also includes 'Data Plagiarism' and 'Self Plagiarism'. Referring to the UGC Notification, 2020, about the reproduction, in part or whole, of one's own previously published work without adequate citation and proper acknowledgment and claiming the most recent work as new



and original for any academic advantage amounts to 'text-recycling' (also known as 'selfplagiarism') and is not acceptable. He further explained that property fitting the argument is the only way to ethically use the information as well as let the readers know of the authentic source of the information or argument made. With the help of citations, readers can also find out more information on the same topic. Attribution includes name, year of publication and the tag. A tag is a hyperlink created in text to reach the references where the article has been referenced using a common style. Dr. Kumar elucidated on the different styles of referencing: MLA, APA, Chicago Manual, Harvard and Vancouver. Depending on the type of journal or the discipline can the authors select the style of referencing.

LaTEX Dr. Nikhil Kumar Rajput

Dr. Nikhil Rajput structured his lecture across two hand-on session. Describing LaTeX, as an application which can simplify text typesetting not only for science discipline but also humanities and social sciences, he explained the interface of the application. He then gave a training session on using the interface for writing.

Systematic Literature Review and Meta - Analysis Dr. Jaspreet Kaur

Dr. Jaspreet Kaur began with a discussion on the meaning of systematic literature and meta - analysis. Referring it as a consolidation of literature Dr. Kaur explained the importance of systematic literature review and the rationale of using it for writing a research paper. She further differentiated between a conventional literature review, systematic literature review (SLR) and meta - analyses. The detailed process of conducting SLR and the area where meta-analysis can be done was explained using a case study. Further, the session detailed on the evidence based minimum set of reporting in SLR and Meta Analysis, that is, PRISMA (Preferred Reporting Items for Systematic Reviews and Meta-Analyses). The introduction to SLR was concluded with a discussion on the selection criteria of research articles for a designated theme using systematic literature review.

ADVANCED RESEARCH METHODOLOGY 2.0

The Ministry of Education (erstwhile, Ministry of Human Resource Development) launched the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) in 2014. One of the main objectives of this mission is to facilitate teacher training by constituting Teaching Learning Centers in various institutions of higher education in our country. The Teaching Learning Centers (TLCs) are mandated to promote on a continuous basis the learning of new pedagogical practices, methodology of forming discipline-specific curricula and creating new learning materials (including e-content) for use by the teachers in colleges and postgraduate departments. It is envisioned that the TLCs will accelerate the teaching-learning process by encouraging independent critical and creative thinking and facilitating research for subject specific growth. The TLCs will assist the faculty in capacity building for curriculum designing, scientific assessment and evaluation and the development of innovative academic programs to strengthen the inclusive nature of higher education. The TLCs are also encouraged to reach out to teachers teaching in regionally disadvantaged locations. The Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission emphasizes the need to change the role and workings of a teacher from a mere disseminator of information and knowledge to the one who helps students to develop critical, analytical skills, capabilities to generate information, the ability to reason and to empower themselves through open sources and globally oriented digitalized self-learning processes. The focus is not only on 'what is taught' but also importantly, to 'the way it is taught,' in an effort to develop and enhance individual education, that will eventually go on to define the manner in which the future generations will work and live. The Teaching Learning Centers offer Faculty Induction Programs (FIPs) for newly recruited faculty and Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) for teachers with experience who wish to update their field of knowledge, expertise and skill with the latest available research, resources and technology. In the FDPs, special emphasis is given to inter and cross-disciplinary methodologies of study.

Currently, the teaching fraternity is missing their lively and interactive classrooms due to COVID-19 Pandemic. To address the present situation, the University Grants Commission (UGC) has intensified its efforts to have a strong virtual engagement with the students through email/WhatsApp and hosting lectures using Google Class Room and other video-conferencing platforms. Keeping in view the immense benefits and reach of online courses in the present academic set-up, the Teaching Learning Centre Ramanujan College, University of Delhi is offering a Two Week Interdisciplinary Refresher Course/ Faculty Development Programme on "Advanced Research Methodology 2.0" for faculty members and research scholars of higher education in the country.

CONCEPT NOTE

Research is a form of systematic enquiry to delve deeper into a subject and produce socially relevant results in different forms like a product, research paper, patent or thesis. There are varied forms of research; each characterized by different methodologies. Research methodology holds prime importance as it outlines the course of the research endeavor and its final outcome. The process of research and the associated tasks need to be conceptualized appropriately to bring in the much needed quality in the research. Every task involved, like collection of data, searching literature review, deriving a mathematical or computational solution or presentation of the results, requires a concrete and systematic approach. Formulation of such an approach requires immense deliberation in terms of the tools and techniques to be deployed as well.

This Online Refresher Course is diligently planned around developing the foundational knowledge needed to step into the arena of research. The programme is an effort towards exploring different dimensions and paradigms of research. The modules intend to enhance the ability of the participants to undertake independent research in a planned manner, appropriate significant literature identify and review. design questionnaires, collect and analyze data, perform simulations and, to assist them in writing research papers for good quality journals. The participants will be trained to use several open source tools that are useful in accomplishing their research outcomes. The primary tools covered are those that would aid a researcher in a systematic background knowledge probe, data visualization, and effective presentation of results, writing research paper, preparation of reports and thesis, and prevention against plagiarism.

The course content is designed to disseminate knowledge of some of the important digital tools used for academic purposes. One will learn how to create individual research profiles, find relevant and good quality journals. The modules would be an amalgamation of the much needed digital skills which can play a significant role throughout the research process.
