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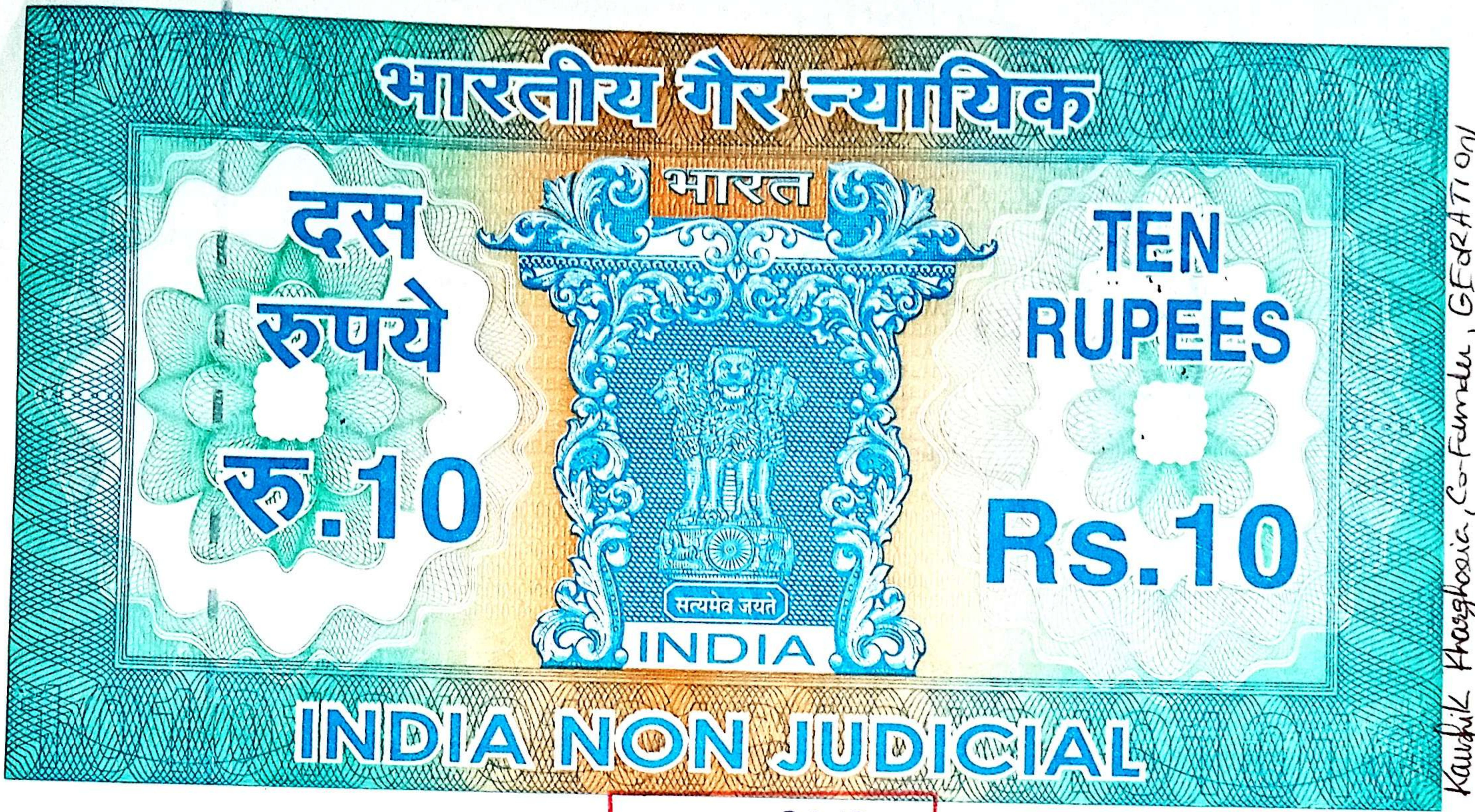

CLAUSE 1

CO- OPERATION

CLAUSE 2

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

2.1 GEORATION will take full responsibility for the computers allotted to the registered students and will pay for their necessary maintenance.

CLAUSE 3

SCOPE OF THE MoU

3.1 GEORATION will provide free career guidance and advice and advice to all the interested

students of Sibsagar Girls College, including both Registered and unregistered students to the provided courses.

3.2 GEORATION will waive full fees of one student every batch that is below poverty life (BPL)

but on the basis of merit.

3.3 GEORATION possesses the authority to put up advertisement banners and do classroom

seminars wherever deemed necessary to make the students aware of their courses.

Shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the courts of Dibrugarh.



Whereas the 2nd Party is the reputed and well skilled Badminton player having the potentiality and good quality of coaching.

And Whereas the 2nd Party on request of some interested boys and girls (six years and above) has decided to give them a coaching of Badminton.

And whereas the 1st Party being the Principal of "The Sibsagar Girls' College", is also the in-charge of the "Sanskriti Badminton Academy, Sivasagar" attached with a "Indoor Stadium and Gym" (hereinafter called the said Academy/coaching centre) situated at the premises of "The Sibsagar Girls' College";

And whereas the 2nd Party approached the 1st Party with a request to allow them to use the said Academy as a coaching centre of Badminton;

And Whereas the 1st Party has agreed to the proposal of the 2nd Party.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS :

1. That the lease shall commence from today i.e. 15th day of March, 2021 a period of one year.
2. That the 2nd Party paid an advance amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) only as refundable security deposit to the 1st Party.
3. That the monthly rent for the said Academy / coaching centre has been fixed at Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) only per month which shall be payable within the 1st week of every month.
4. That apart from the monthly rent, the electricity bills/charges against the said Academy/coaching centre during the lease period, shall be paid by the 2nd Party separately.
5. That the said Academy/coaching centre shall be kept by the 2nd Party in neat and clean condition and for its cleanliness there shall be a care taker in the said Academy/coaching centre.
6. That the 2nd Party shall pay a monthly salary of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only to the care taker.
7. That the said Academy/coaching centre shall be used by the 1st Party for the purpose of giving Badminton coaching only.
8. That from Monday to Saturday, i.e., in all working days there will be two sessions (morning and evening) of coaching and on Sundays and other holidays, there will be three sessions (morning, afternoon and evening) of coaching.
9. That the players of the coaching centre shall be at liberty to use the attached "Gym" in the said Academy/coaching centre.
10. That for management of the said Academy/coaching centre there will be a Managing Committee to be formed by members of both the parties.

PARAGRAPH-I

UNDERLYING PRINCIPLES

1. Both the parties agree to follow the General Principles of Mutual Cooperation to promote Skill Enhancement & Entrepreneurship Development Courses & Schemes of the Proposed Innovation & Incubation Centre, Sibsagar Girls' College.

PARAGRAPH-II

SCOPE OF UNDERSTANDING

- Mutual activities under this MOU are meant for full operation of the Innovation and Incubation Centre, Sibsagar Girls' College
- The Innovation and Incubation Centre, Sibsagar Girls' College intends to launch a few Skill Development courses like, Handloom and Textile, Food Preservation, Soft Skills, Enterprise Development, Personality Development, SHG & NGO management, Pisciculture, Floriculture, Historical Monument Study with tourist guide training and feasible courses to be added later on as and when required, etc. wherein both the parties agree to impart respective strategic planning as shown in the **Organogram of Collaboration**.
- Both the parties agree to make necessary arrangement for Theory & Practical Classes and Experiential Learning (field Study).
- The First Party agrees to provide required infrastructure for running the Centre.
- The Second Party agrees to issue Course Completion Certificate.
- Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Sibsagar Girls' College will be associated with the activities on the part of the First Party.

DISCLAIMER

Both the parties consult together upon request of either side regarding any matter relating to terms and conditions of MOU and will resolve jointly any difficulties or misunderstandings which may arise during its course of operation in a spirit of cooperation and mutual trust.

AMENDMENT

The MOU may be amended at any point of time by agreement of both the parties.

PERIOD OF OPERATION

- The MOU will come into effect on the date of Signing by both the parties
- The MOU will remain in effect for an initial period of 5 years and will be extended for successive period of one(1) year, unless either sides notifies the other side in writing.
- Termination of the MOU must be notified before three(3) months of expiry date of the MOU period by either side.

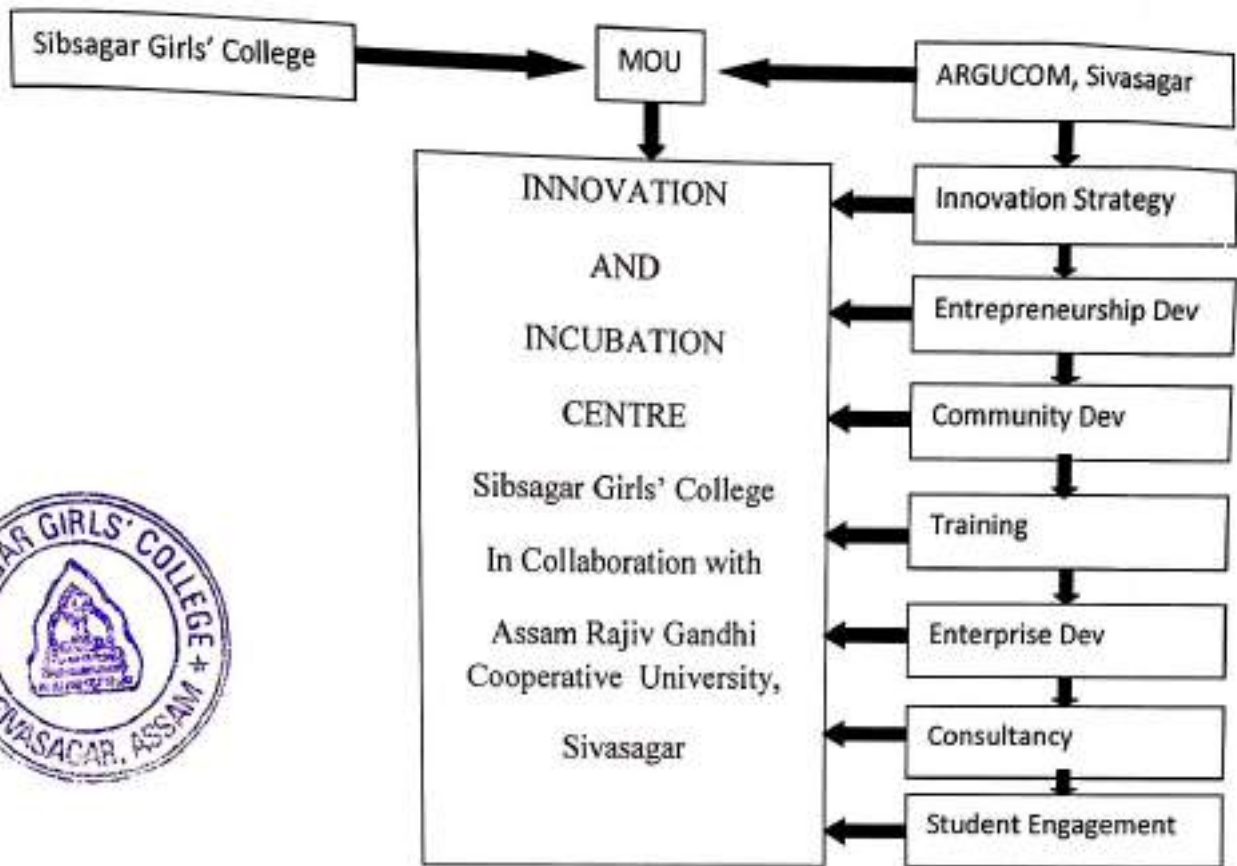

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

English Language Teachers' Association of India (ELTAI) Upper Assam Chapter

1. Purpose

With the object of promoting their co-operation and collaboration in English language education, training and research, Sibsagar Girls' College and ELTAI Upper Assam chapter individually also "Party" and collectively the "Parties", enter into the following Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU").

2. Forms of Co-operation

Within such fields as are mutually acceptable for the Parties, the following forms of co-operation, amongst others, may be pursued hereunder:

- a. Joint teaching activities in the field of English language
- b. Joint training activities in the field of English language
- c. Joint research/survey activities in the field of English language
- d. Visits by English Language Experts of ELTAI to Sibsagar Girls' College for theoretical and hands-on training in the field of English language to their students on mutually convenient time.

For this, the scope of cooperation will be such:

1. The first party (Sibsagar Girls' College) agrees to provide their infrastructural facilities as and when required for teaching/training/research purposes.
2. The first party may also provide faculty and other staff for any assistance if required.

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4. The second party (ELTAI) agrees to provide course completion certificate, if any.

3. Financial Arrangements

Both Parties understand that all financial arrangements between the Parties have to be further negotiated and mutually agreed, and will depend on the availability of funds. Both parties may seek financing of joint activities from internal and external sources available to them.

4. General Coordinators

Each Party shall designate a coordinating officer to oversee and facilitate the implementation of this agreement.

5. Liability

Except for loss or damages caused through gross negligence or intent, the Parties shall have no liability to each other hereunder.

6. Legal Relationship

This MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the Parties. Nothing in this MoU shall create any legal relationship between the Parties.

7. Commencement, Renewal, Termination

This MoU will be effective from the date of the last signature hereto and will remain in force for a time period of three (3) years, with a possibility for renewal at the end of the period, subject to the Parties' written agreement. Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving six (6) months' notice in writing to the other Party.

This MoU has been drawn up in two (2) original copies in the English language, each Party receiving one duly signed copy hereof.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Based on the stated Policy (No. 002), subject to amendment as and when necessity comes in .

Prologue

The Sibsagar Girls' College, Sivasagar, Assam, 785640 with a wooden Badminton court constructed an Indoor Stadium in the Science campus with the financial grant of UGC during the 12th Plan period (2012-2017). The Indoor Stadium even though was meant for the development of the Students' Sports, it was at the very beginning found rarely attended by the student's community. The college authority, in contrary, organised Training camps for Badminton and Volley Ball, constituted Indoor Stadium Management Committee, invited professional trainers and what not to imbibe student's interest in sports. During the post 12th Plan period when UGC stopped funding the Sibsagar Girls' College had been able to get awarded with the Upgradation of Existing Colleges into Model Degree College by Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA). Along with other Infrastructural facilities, Sports equipments were also procured and eventually the existing Indoor Stadium had been upgraded to a state of the Art infrastructure. But the college didn't have an outdoor playground since its inception. As a result, the college authority approached the nearby Fuleswari Girls' Higher Secondary School authority to discuss Common Sharing of the Playground located between the two institutions. A joint by-party delegation had also been taken place in the month of February, 2022 where the matter of signing MOU was unanimously resolved.

Preamble

The Sibsagar Girls' College as a Public Educational Institution intends to mobilise her internal resources for,
The Fullest Functioning of Existing Resources ;
The Fullest benefit of Students and also the Community;
The Sharing and Exchange Resources with the Stakeholders.

In this sitting of the Governing Body, Sibsagar Girls' College dated 26th March, 2022 signed this **Memorandum of Understanding** to use the Fuleswari Girls' Higher Secondary School Playground for the interest of the Sibsagar Girls' College Students from 2022 onwards.

- 1) The Memorandum of Understanding hereinafter will be known as **MOU**.
- 2) The Sibsagar Girls' College, Near Sivadol, Sivsagar town, Sivasagar, Assam-785640, hereinafter will be known as the **First Party**.
- 3) The Fuleswari Girls' Higher Secondary School, Sivasgar Town, Sivasagar, Assam-785640, hereinafter will be known as the **Second Party**.
- 4) The MOU is drafted on the basis of SIBSAGAR GIRLS' COLLEGE RESOURCE MOBILISATION POLICY, stated in the Preamble (Policy No.002) OF 2022.
- 5) The MOU shall come into force at once i.e. from April, 2022 onwards.

Amendment

This MOU is subject to amendment at any point of time by agreement of the College Authority (**First Party**) and the Fuleswari Girls' Higher Secondary School (**Second Party**).

PARAS of the

PARA-I UNDERLYING PRINCIPLES

PARA-I

1. Both the parties agree to follow the General Principles of Mutual Cooperation to promote Sports activities among the students.
2. Both the Parties agree to Cooperate and share Services/facilities to carry out this MOU and intend not to create any legally binding rights and obligations.

Para-I (Clause 1 & 2) follow the Memorandum of Association as per Assam Cooperative Society's Act

PARA-II SCOPE OF UNDERSTANDING

1. The First party expresses interest to get the services of the Second party's playground . The Second party also willingly accepts the First party's expression of interest.
2. The Second party's playground will be shared by the First party once the MOU is signed by both the parties.
- 3.Both the parties agree to share existing Sports facilities for the interests of the students.
4. The First party agrees to develop the playground in a phased manner. The Second party also agrees to cooperate the First party in the developmental works.
- 5.Both the parties agree to fortify the playground with secure iron fencing/ boundary wall and also agree to set up two entrance gate, each for both the parties.

PARA-II

6. Both the parties agree to chalk out Annual Sports Calendar without hampering each other every year.
7. Both the parties agree to form a Playground Management Committee for Physical maintenance of the Playground and gearing up of the Sports activity therein.
8. The First party also agrees to set up Academic Collaboration with the Second party .

Para-II Clause 7 requires a Playground Management Committee based on Assam Govt. Sports Rule (if any).

PARA-III
TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING

PARA-III

1. Both the parties, i.e. the First and the Second Party willingly formed the Association to the best each other's common knowledge and spirit.

2. Both the Parties shall continue the Association . No term of Renewal shall be applied to continue Association of both the parties. In the event of any unexpected issue(s) coming up between the parties that may affect the Understanding adversely, both the parties will initially short out solution in a tripartite sitting, i.e. the First Party, Second Party and the Governing Body, Sibsagar Girls' College.

Para-III Clause 2 requires a Legal Binding between the parties.

3. The MOU will come into effect on the date of Signing by both the parties.

4. The MOU will remain in effect forever.

5. The establishments expected to come into existence after enactment of the MOU will be considered as the Common Resource for both the parties.

6. Both the parties agree to take steps for Public Disclosure of the MOU.







This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 28/03/2019 to establish an affiliation by and between Department of Mathematics & Statistics of Sibsagar Commerce College affiliated to Dibrugarh University hereinafter referred to as SCCM, of the FIRST PART.

And

Department of Mathematics of Sibsagar Girls' College affiliated to Dibrugarh University hereinafter referred to as SGCM, of the Second Part, for the purpose of exchange of faculties.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

Preamble

WHEREAS, SCCM and SGCM have many areas of common interest in Mathematics and Statistics, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education and research. NOW, THEREFORE, SCCM and SGCM have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.
The two institutions shall seek to promote:

- (iv) to organize jointly seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- (v) to propose and engage jointly in research or training programs sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- (vi) the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of both institutes.

SCCM and SGCM agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf as well as to maintain the attendance register for the faculty. Also for smooth functioning of the said programme faculty of Dept. of Mathematics of both institutions will meet at the beginning of Academic session. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of SCCM, and a programme coordinator from the side of SGCM, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Both the institutes do not absolve any confidential information during the research activity.

ARTICLE 4: VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of FIVE years commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 5: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of three months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither SCCM nor SGCM will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, SCCM and SGCM will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

ARTICLE 6: AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

In case, there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principal SCCM and SGCM will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.



4. Registration fee of Rs. 1450/- for faculty members will be charged through the IMPS/NEFT/UPI which **will be non-refundable**.




